## Texans of All Political Stripes Reject Private School Vouchers, Will Rally for the Future of Public Education

Texas public school advocates will call on the Texas Legislature to reject private school vouchers at the Capitol on Saturday in anticipation of a special session starting Monday.

Austin, Texas — After a regular legislative session that, despite a record state budget surplus, ended with no increase in per-student funding for Texas schools, and with a special session on taxpayer-funded vouchers called for October 9, public education advocates from across the state are gathering at the Texas Capitol this Saturday to send a clear and loud message: Texans do not want taxpayer-funded vouchers. There is no deal we will accept.

"The education of 5.4 million Texas school children must be our state's priority," said Troy Reynolds, an educator and founder of Texans for Public Education. "Private school vouchers take money away from our public schools, fail to hold private schools to the same standards as public schools, and distract from the legislature's constitutional obligation to establish and make suitable provision for the support and maintenance of an efficient system of public free schools. **We are united in our opposition to private school vouchers!**"

**What:** Supporters of public education from across the state, including parents, grandparents, pastors, teachers, students, businesspeople, school board trustees, school superintendents and Texas taxpayers are joining together to say NO to private school VOUCHERS!
